For years, Tom & Suzi Skoglund did many shows as crafters and started the Prairie Peddler Festival to provide another venue for crafters and customers to come together. Today, Suzi continues to run the festival with her daughter, Mandie. We are grateful that we work with some great people that help make the festival a huge success every year. The festival is in it's 35th year and has become a tradition for so many. With over 200 vendors, live music & food, visitors come from all over Ohio and surrounding states to shop, eat and enjoy everything the festival has to offer. We are conveniently located between Cleveland and Columbus, just a few miles off I-71 making it a great location for those from the Cleveland and Columbus areas to get out of the city and enjoy the fresh country air!

Application process:

1. Fill out the application completely. Submit your application and pictures online.
2. The committee looks for the following when jurying applications: quality products that have saleability with our customer base, a 'boutique look' in booth display, and we consider the number of vendors already signed up in the product category.
3. Upon acceptance, your spot will ONLY be reserved once the show fee is paid in full.

Guidelines for Selling

1. Items in your booth must be handmade by the vendor(s) unless other items are approved by the committee upon submission of application.
2. The festival committee will evaluate on an individual basis requests for more than one craft category in a space.
3. We encourage you to demonstrate your work. Customers enjoy watching the artist demonstrations and we continue to get requests to see more at the show.
4. **For Food Concessions inquiries- contact us for availability.**

Display, Sales & Booth Structure

1. We highly recommend 1st time vendors to either use a tent or do a booth rental before considering buying or constructing a booth. All new construction and booth sales must be approved by the festival. Buying a booth does not guarantee acceptance into the show.
2. Booths/tents should be decorated for fall. Pumpkins, mums, straw bales & corn stalks are easy and inexpensive ways to enhance your display. Corner poles on canopies should be covered with corn stalks, fabric or burlap.
3. Your display needs to be confined to the size space marked on your application.
4. No sales are to be made outside the designated booth area. No hawking permitted.
5. Displays should be appealing and neat and tables should be covered to the ground. Plastic tarps are not to be visible during show hours (exception-increment weather). All stock and storage boxes must be hidden from view.
6. To obtain a vendor's license: Ohio Department of Taxation at (888)405-4039. For food license: Richland County Health Department at (419)774-4500.

Miscellaneous

1. Primitive camping available at no charge for our vendors but you will need to let us know ahead of time that you will be camping on-site.
2. Pets are not allowed on show grounds when the festival is open.
3. We reserve the right to ask anyone to leave that is displaying extreme behavior (i.e. causing a disruption to others, defacing of property).
